### Lab 01 – VIM Tutorial

## Introduction

In this lab session, you will be working on the VIM Tutorial available with your GNU/Linux installation (e.g., OpenSUSE 11.x). You will need to complete all lessons in the tutorial on your own if you do not finish all of them in the lab.

If you installed OpenSUSE 11.2 on your home machine, for example, the tutorial must already be installed. To run the tutorial, type `vimtutor` at the command line.

This command will open a new VIM session with the tutorial loaded. Simply read and follow the tutorial.

Remember that you will be responsible for all VIM commands especially in your lab exams! So make sure you learn VIM/GVIM well.
